MAIN ACTIONS IN HUMANITARIAN RESPONSE

- 955 people** received hygiene kits
- 8,746 people** received cash transfers
- 306 people** assisted with emergency accommodation
- 292 people** received food assistance
- 1,751 people** received health assistance
- 3,191 people** received legal advice
- 12,511 people** received social care and psychological aid
- 1.750,000 soap bars and 20,000 protective face shields** donated to vulnerable people.
- 4,500 milk liters** donated to rural communities.
